

EXPENDITURES

2015 was an important year of growth and impact for Bluegrass Greensource. While numbers are important, they only tell one part of the story. Read below to learn more about the impact we made in Central Kentucky last year!

MAIN STREET CLEAN SWEEP

On Earth Day 2015, 969 volunteers in 19 Central Kentucky communities filled 650 bags with litter, removing nearly 4 tons of waste from their communities.



INVESTING IN COMMUNITIES

In 2015, Bluegrass Greensource invested \$69,478 - and leveraged an additional \$14,732 of investment - into green infrastructure that will lead to cleaner, healthier streams and rivers.

RESOURCE LIBRARY

Bluegrass Greensource's library is available to teachers and organizations in need of resources for lessons and activities that increase environmental literacy. Last year, 54 organizations utilized our library, impacting 800 people.



GREENFEST

In 2015, 300 people joined us for the first annual GreenFest, a fun-filled day of workshops and activities designed to teach the skills needed for a more sustainable life.
